**ATCO Structures Completes Multi-Million Dollar Contract for
In Salah Gas Project in Algeria**

Calgary, Alberta – The European division of ATCO Structures announced today that they have completed manufacturing and delivery of a facility for the In Salah Gas Project, jointly operated by BP Exploration (In Salah) Limited and Sonatrach, Algeria's state oil and gas company. The temporary facilities will accommodate over 1000 people in four different construction sites across Algeria.

The contract included the supply of living accommodations, dormitories, kitchen/dining, recreation, offices, warehouses, maintenance buildings and clinics, along with electrical, mechanical and civil services. The project was manufactured within four months in ATCO Structures' Budapest, Hungary and Diboll, Texas plants, and transported by sea to Algeria. JGC-KBR Venture will complete site installation.
